

The book list is color-coded to aid in student book selection. Each color corresponds to ranges in AR reading levels. Teachers are encouraged to help students select a mix of challenging and fun/less challenging books for their students.

## BOOK ICONS IDENTIFY CHARACTERISTICS KIDS ENJOY



**Bilingual** books are written in both English and Spanish.



**Series** books are part of a series or collection.



**Fiction/Nonfiction** marks the genre of a book.



**Award Winner** books and/or their authors have won awards.



**Multiethnic** books feature characters of 2+ ethnicities.




**Student Favorites** are books our students enjoyed most!

## DISCOVERY SHEETS

Each KRN book has a Discovery Sheet containing a book code and four reading activities. The activities:

- Encourage students to think or talk about what they read.
- Help build comprehension. They also help students relate something they have read to their own lives, or the lives of others.
- Encourage parents to pick one of the questions, and complete the suggested task with their child.

## HOW TO SELECT BOOKS

### 1. With your students:

Help each student select eight Wish List books according to their reading ability and interests.

### 2. After they have chosen their books:

Visit [portal.kidsreadnow.org](http://portal.kidsreadnow.org) and have each student enter the provided class code and select their name. They will then be able to lock in their book choices! Benefits of online selection include seeing a couple pages of each book as well as the activity questions. You can also filter for reading level and genre to display only books that are of interest/appropriate for that particular student.

### 3. After the student's books are selected online, parents should review and confirm their contact information online at [portal.kidsreadnow.org](http://portal.kidsreadnow.org). **This step is critical for proper delivery of books to kids' homes.**




## SCHOOLS CHOOSE THE PRIZES
